

Dogs NZ Scentwork Workshop Invitation

A number of you will be aware of a new Dogs NZ venture called Scent Work. This has been shared in the Dogs NZ DOG-iE News and NZ Dog World, which may have sparked in some of you some interest.

An inaugural “[Introduction to Dogs NZ Scentwork](#)” workshop was held on the CKA grounds on 15th December, with a subsequent workshop being held at Forrester Park on January 18th. Both workshops were over-subscribed (being restricted to 20 persons), and so yet another is planned for March 21st, again at the CKA grounds.

These workshops:

- A brief summary of what has been happening to date regarding Dogs NZ involvement in Scentwork and the direction it is anticipated it will be continuing to develop in.
- Imprinting (which includes an opportunity for you to imprint your dog).
- Introductory training for the Dogs NZ Novice Container Search Trials.

Registration shall also be on a first applied basis.
